Topic: Major Motor Vehicle Crash – DWI Investigation

700 Mid-Cities Blvd at 700 Martin Drive: On May 1, 2014, at approximately 4:38 AM, Hurst Police and Fire Units responded to the intersection of 700 Mid-Cities Blvd and 700 Martin Drive in regard to a major motor vehicle crash where a vehicle had crashed through a brick privacy wall then into a home.

The investigation revealed that the vehicle, a 2002 Ford 4dr, driven by a 27 year old male North Richland Hills resident, was traveling east on Martin Drive. The driver failed to stop at the intersection at Mid-Cities Blvd, crossed over three lanes, struck the center median divider, bounding over three additional lanes, struck the curb line, then crashed through a brick privacy wall, through the back yard then through the kitchen/breakfast nook window and wall of the home located in the 2600 block of Bent Tree Circle. Fortunately the residents were sleeping in a distant area of the home and no one in the residence was injured.

The 27 year old driver of the Ford was treated at the scene and later transported by ambulance to JPS Fort Worth with non-life threatening injuries. An investigation for Driving While Intoxicated is being conducted.

With the probability of substantial structural damage to the residence, and at the request of the homeowner, the vehicle was left at the scene still embedded into the residence, pending the home owner's arrangement for structural inspection and safety concerns prior to removal.
