

IS A GARAGE SALE PERMIT REQUIRED?

No, the tenants of a residential dwelling may offer their personal belongings and household effects for sale to the general public with no requirement for obtaining a permit.

HOW LONG CAN A GARAGE SALE LAST?

The interval between each sale shall be at least **six** (6) months, and no sale period shall extend for more than three (3) consecutive calendar days.

CAN I PLACE SIGNS OUT FOR MY GARAGE SALE?

Yes, signs may be placed in any yard where the holder has permission. Signs may be put out five (5) days before the sale and must be removed within twenty-four (24) hours after the sale.

CAN SIGNS BE PLACED ON TELEPHONE POLES?

No, signs are not allowed on any high line or telephone poles, street, or traffic sign poles.

CAN SIGNS BE PLACED ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AREA?

No, signs placed in the street right-of-way (ROW) will be picked up by the City crews.

WHAT IS CONSIDERED STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY?

Street right-of-way in the **City of Hurst** is ten (10) feet behind the curb on each side of the street.

CAN SEVERAL FAMILIES HAVE GARAGE SALES TOGETHER?

Yes, it is permissible for more than one family to combine their personal belongings and household effects for sale to the general public.

WHAT IS THE LARGEST GARAGE SALE SIGN I MAY HAVE?

The total sign area of all your signs shall not exceed eight (8) square feet. Lighted signs are prohibited.

IS A GARAGE SALE PERMIT REQUIRED?

HOW LONG CAN A GARAGE SALE LAST?

The interval between each sale shall be at least six (6) months, and no sale period shall

CAN I PLACE SIGNS OUT FOR MY GARAGE SALE?

Yes, signs may be placed in any yard where the holder has permission. Signs may be put out five (5) days before the sale and must be removed within twenty-four (24) hours after the sale.

CAN SIGNS BE PLACED ON TELEPHONE POLES?

No, signs are not allowed on any high line or telephone poles, street, or traffic sign poles.

CAN SIGNS BE PLACED ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AREA?

No, signs placed in the street right-of-way (ROW) will be picked up by the City crews.

WHAT IS CONSIDERED STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY?

Street right-of-way in the **City of Hurst** is ten (10) feet behind the curb on each side of the street.

CAN SEVERAL FAMILIES HAVE GARAGE SALES TOGETHER?

Yes, it is permissible for more than one family to combine their personal belongings and household effects for sale to the general public.

WHAT IS THE LARGEST GARAGE SALE SIGN I MAY HAVE?

The total sign area of all your signs shall not exceed eight (8) square feet. Lighted signs are prohibited.
