FIGHT THE BITE

Mosquito season is upon us, and we're here to help you avoid those pesky bites! The best defense against mosquitoes is to practice the "Four Ds":

1. Use insect repellent containing DEET, picaridin or oil of lemon eucalyptus.
2. Dress in long sleeves and long pants when you are outside.
3. Stay indoors at dusk and dawn, when mosquitoes are most active.
4. Drain standing water where mosquitoes breed. Common breeding sites include old tires, flowerpots and clogged rain gutters.

WATER CONSERVATION

As temperatures rise, water conservation becomes even more important. Here are some tips to help with your water conservation efforts:

- Know when to water: every Monday SaveTarrantWater.com provides weekly watering advice that takes weather conditions into account.
- Keeping your irrigation cycles short (6-8 min/cycle for spray heads; 12-14 min/cycle for rotors) will minimize runoff and water waste.

Remember the city guidelines:

1. No watering with irrigation or sprinkler systems between 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.
2. Watering by hand-held hose, drip irrigation, or soaker hose is allowed at any time.
3. No more than two hours per day maximum is encouraged.
