## Daycare/Group Policy Hurst Aquatic Centers

- 1. A Daycare/Group is defined as any person or entity, commercial, in home care or non-profit, who provides structured child care and/or activities, whether year round or seasonal.
- 2. Any Daycare/Group meeting these criteria will be required to make a reservation. Reservations can be made over the phone at 817-788-7325 or in person, at the City of Hurst Recreation Administration Office, 700 Mary Drive, a minimum of seven (7) working days in advance of the desired date of visit.
- 3. Reservations will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis beginning the third Monday of March for Hurst groups and the first Monday in April for non-Hurst groups.
- 4. Daycare/Group reservations will be available beginning the first day of the season and continuing throughout the summer season. Reservations are Monday Friday, beginning at 12:30pm.
- 5. Only two reservations per week per Daycare/Group will be allowed.
- 6. Daycare/Group reservation fees are subject to residency and are as follows:
  With-in Hurst city limits (proof required) Central \$4/person, Chisholm \$6/person, including adults
  Non-Hurst groups Central \$10/person, Chisholm \$12/person, including adults
- 7. The maximum allowable size of a Daycare/Group is fifty (50) children with the appropriate number of adult supervisors.
- 8. Daycares/Groups must comply with the following adult to child ratios:

Ages 7 & under: one (1) adult per four (4) children
Ages 8 & older: one (1) adult per seven (7) children
NOTE: Ratios must be maintained or admission will be denied.

- Adult supervisors must be a minimum of sixteen (16) years old and must be <u>actively supervising at</u> <u>all times</u>. This means attired in an approved swimsuit and watching from in the water or the side <u>walls of the pools</u>. Adult supervisors must wear identifying material (wristband or lanyard) as provided by the City of Hurst.
- 10. The adult supervisors are responsible for their actions, as well as the actions of the children.
- 11. All pool rules and regulations that apply to the general public will be enforced.
- 12. Daycares/Groups must have transportation on-site and ready for immediate exit from the facility, if necessary.
- 13. The City of Hurst reserves the right to deny Daycare/Group admission or void standing reservations at any time.
