Proper Clothing Required: All persons entering the courtroom should be dressed in clothing reasonably befitting the dignity and solemnity of the court proceedings.

Exempt or Disqualified: YOU MUST COMPLETE THIS FORM, AND RETURN TO THE HURST MUNICIPAL COURT PRIOR TO THE DATE YOU ARE SUMMONED TO APPEAR. PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT BUSINESS AND PERSONAL REASONS ARE NOT QUALIFIED EXEMPTIONS. **MUST PROVIDE COPY OF DRIVER'S LICENSE.**

To serve as a juror you <i>must</i> meet qualifications:	You may claim an exemption from jury service if you: (Check appropriate box)
1. be at least 18 years of age;	<input type="checkbox"/> you are over 70 years of age - Date of Birth: ___/___/___;
2. be a citizen of this state and a resident of the county (city) in which you are to serve as a juror;	<input type="checkbox"/> you have legal custody of a child or children younger than 12 years of age and service on the jury would require leaving the child or children without adequate supervision;

3.	be qualified under the Constitution and laws to vote in the county in which you are to serve as a juror (<i>Note: you DO NOT have to be registered to vote to be qualified to vote</i>);	<input type="checkbox"/>	you are a student at a public or private high school Name of school _____ Location of school _____;
4.	be of sound mind and good moral character;	<input type="checkbox"/>	you are enrolled and in actual attendance at an institution of higher education Name of school _____ Location of school _____;

9.	be a resident of the municipality for which the court is established.
