

HURST KIDZ

Guidelines/Policies:

1. A Hurst Recreation Center membership is required to purchase a Hurst Kidz pass.
2. Hurst Kidz is limited to 1.5 hours per child per day.
3. Three children per household, per visit.
4. Availability is on a first-come, first-served basis. No reservations are required.
5. Full payment at the front desk is required at drop-off time. Please show the receipt/pass to the Hurst Kidz attendant. Passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.
6. Check-in/out requires the guardian to show a Photo ID, with no exceptions.
7. For safety reasons, we will only release children to the same person who brought them in.
8. Guardians must always remain within the Hurst Recreation Center while the child is at Hurst Kidz. No exceptions. Members found to have left the building will lose their Hurst Kidz privileges for 30 days, and Hurst PD may be notified.
9. Food is not allowed. Sippy cups, with water only, are permitted.
10. Toys from home are not allowed in the Hurst Kidz area.
11. Pacifiers and comfort items such as blankets are permitted.
12. Please label all items brought to the Hurst Kidz area. Hurst Kidz and Hurst Recreation Center staff are not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen items.
13. Please change your child's diaper, or have them use the restroom before checking them into the Hurst Kidz area. Staff will not change diapers. We will notify the guardian if a child needs a diaper change or assistance in the restroom.
14. Children must wear shoes while visiting the Hurst Kidz area.
15. If your child displays inappropriate behavior that cannot be solved by reasoning or redirection, we will ask the guardian to sign the child out from Hurst Kidz area for the remainder of the day. If the child is "written up" 3 times in a 2-week period for inappropriate behavior, we will suspend the child from Hurst Kidz for a 30-day period.
16. We expect Guardians and children to adhere to the Sick Child Policy as a health standard and courtesy to others.

Hurst Recreation childcare is not a licensed day care facility by the State of Texas.

Sick Child Policy:

Please do not bring your child to the Hurst Kidz area if:

- Child has a fever of 100.4 or higher
- Child has vomited within the past 24 hours
- Child has had a watery stool in the past 24 hours
- Child has a rash not associated with diapers
- Child has a sore throat and or cough
- Child has symptoms of a possible communicable disease including but not limited to sniffles, red eyes, sore throat, headache, abdominal pain, fever, and/or skin spots, bumps, or patches
- Child has been exposed to a person that is confirmed positive for COVID-19

If staff observes any of these symptoms, or any additional symptoms indicating illness, during the child's visit, we will ask the guardian to remove the child.

Guardians may be notified during their child's stay if:

- Child needs a diaper change or needs assistance to use the restroom
- Child is crying for more than 10 minutes
- Child is not following instructions from staff
- A stay that exceeds the 1.5-hour time limit
- Staff feel the child is sick
- Staff feels the child needs their guardian
- Staff feels the child is perceived to pose danger to themselves or others
