

TRAIN MAINTENANCE ASSISTANT

Hurst Public Library, 901 Precinct Line Road

QUALIFICATIONS

The Hurst Overland Reader's Railroad is a G-scale model train system, situated above the Youth Services Department on a 30' x 30' double track suspension system.

Preferred qualifications include familiarity with G-scale trains and proficiency in disassembling, lubricating, and reassembling engines and cars.

Staff will provide training as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Grease, oil, and maintain engines and cars.
- Clean and maintain the track.
- Ensure the operability of the remote control system.
- Perform additional maintenance tasks as necessary for smooth operation.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at minimum 18 years old.
- Time commitment: 1 to 2 hours per week during Library hours as required to maintain train.
- No criminal record.
- Physical demands
 - Must be able to climb a ladder, stand, push, pull, lift (up to 15 lbs.), reach, bend, and stoop for extended periods.
- Mental demands
 - Speak and write clearly.
 - Comprehend, retain, and follow oral and written instructions.
 - Effectively communicate.
- Work environment
 - The volunteer will work indoors, ensuring protection from weather conditions.
 - They will operate in a clean, well-ventilated, and well-lit environment
 - Moderate traffic and distractions in the immediate area.
