QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a United States citizen, aged 21 or older, with a demonstrated good moral character.
- Successful completion of the application, background check, and training processes is required.
- Graduation from the Hurst Citizen Police Academy is mandatory.

Staff will provide training as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate a marked COPS car throughout the city.
- Document minor problems or issues encountered during patrols.
- Alert dispatch of emergency situations promptly.
- Perform vacation house checks as assigned.
- Issue handicap parking violations.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at minimum 21 years old.
- Time commitment: 4 hours per week preferred; however, any hours are appreciated.
- No criminal record.
 - The Police Department will conduct an extensive background check.
- Physical demands
 - Must be able to drive, sit, walk, talk, hear, see, and stand.
- Mental demands
 - Read, speak, and write clearly.
 - Comprehend, retain, and follow oral and written instructions.
 - Effectively communicate.
- Work environment
 - Volunteer will work outside and be exposed to varying weather conditions.
 - Volunteer will have interaction with the public.
