QUALIFICATIONS

- Capability to walk and bathe dogs.

Staff will provide training as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Bathe and engage with shelter animals to keep them entertained.
- Walk animals to ensure they get regular exercise.
- Assist in cleaning and sanitizing animal cages and kennels.
- Help with laundry and washing dishes.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at minimum 18 years old.
- No criminal record.
- Comfort in a work environment with exposure to:
 - Loud noises
 - Cleaning chemicals
 - Animal waste
- Dependable and reliable.
- Must follow safety protocols and guidelines provided by the shelter.
- Physical demands:
 - Ability to handle dogs of various sizes and temperaments.
 - Strong visual and hearing acuity.
 - Capable of pulling, pushing, lifting, reaching, bending, and stooping for prolonged durations.
- Work environment
 - May involve exposure to seasonal weather elements.
