QUALIFICATIONS

- Willing and able to perform physical activities in emergency situations.
- Desire to give back to the community and support local safety efforts.
- Must pass a background screening.
- Committed to completing the CERT Basic Training, which consists of a 3-day course.

Staff will provide training as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Respond to local emergencies and provide critical support to professional first responders.
- Apply training in disaster preparedness, fire suppression, basic medical care, and light search and rescue operations.
- Assist in community outreach and emergency preparedness activities as needed.
- Maintain readiness to deploy in emergencies by participating in regular drills and refresher training.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Reside or work within Hurst city limits.
- No criminal record.
- All volunteers must successfully complete the CERT Basic Training class, which covers:
 - Disaster preparedness
 - Small fire suppression
 - Basic medical procedures
 - Light search and rescue operations

Additional Information: Volunteers should be prepared to invest time in regular training and be available to assist during community-wide emergencies. This role is ideal for individuals passionate about community service and public safety.
