

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

February 24, 2017

In an effort to improve and upgrade the City's infrastructure, the City of Hurst will soon begin construction on Pipeline Road between Precinct Line Road and Lorean Branch Bridge. The project will consist of widening the roadway and replacing the existing asphalt pavement with 8" reinforced concrete pavement with center turn lanes and landscaped medians. Water, sewer and storm drain lines will be improved and sidewalks with pedestrian lighting will also be added. The project is estimated to require 18 months to complete.

Throughout the course of the project the contractor will make every effort to keep traffic flowing and any foreseen service disruptions kept to a minimum.
