



SETTING UP A NEW BUSINESS

Certificate of Occupancy:

A Certificate of Occupancy is required for new businesses operating in Hurst. The application can be accessed online at www.hursttx.gov/css, and there is a \$60.00 application fee. After an approved inspection, Hurst Building Inspections gives a utility release to Oncor. The customer is responsible for starting their services to the various utility companies. A new Certificate of Occupancy is also required when a business changes ownership, square footage or type of business. It is necessary to have all of the information requested on the application before it can be processed.

Signs:

An approved sign permit must be obtained prior to erecting any sign. An application with digital drawings must be submitted by contractor online at www.hursttx.gov/css. A plan review fee will be invoiced when the sign permit application is submitted, and the permit fee is paid when sign permit is issued.

Restaurants:

The Tarrant County Health Department must be contacted prior to opening, or obtaining a building permit to remodel or build a new structure. Tarrant County Health Department approved plans must be submitted to the Building Inspection Department along with a building permit application. The Tarrant County Health Department is located at 1101 S Main Street in Fort Worth and can be reached by phone at (817) 321-4960.

In order to process an application for a Certificate of Occupancy for any restaurant, a seating layout is required with plans showing square footage of kitchen, bathroom, storage, etc. to allow proper classification.
